



DAY ONE:

- On your way to New York's Capital City, stop by the [Brookview Station Winery at Goold Orchards](#) and/or the [Hudson-Chatham Winery](#) and experience their award-winning wines with a group tasting. Visit the Farm Store at Goold Orchards as well for baked-daily goods and fresh seasonal produce.
- Upon leaving Goold, take the 25-minute ride to Albany's historic downtown area, where your group's hotel will be located in the midst of hundreds of years of architecture. Drive past the [New York State Capitol Building](#), the [State Education Building](#), and [Governor Nelson Rockefeller's Empire State Plaza](#).
- Arrive at your hotel for check in and a welcome reception for your group. Relax in preparation for dinner at one of our many diverse downtown restaurants.
- Afterward, there are many options for shows and live entertainment at the [Palace Theatre](#), [Capital Repertory Theatre](#), the [Times Union Center arena](#), or the [Egg](#).

DAY TWO:

- Enjoy breakfast at your hotel.
- Afterward, visit the [New York State Museum](#) or join a Step-On Guide at the [Albany Visitors Center](#) for a morning historic tour of Albany.
- It's Noon! Make your way down to the [Albany Pump Station](#), our downtown brewpub which is the home of Evans Ale. Take a tour and chat with the Master Brewer, taste the fresh-brewed selections, and then enjoy lunch in the beautiful historic building.
- After lunch, visit the [Albany Distilling Company](#)—Albany's newest addition to the beverage circuit for a tour and tasting. Try a sample and learn about our City's first working distillery open since Prohibition.
- After lunch, board your motorcoach and finish your weekend with an Albany attraction or take a ride to one of the other wineries or breweries within 90 minutes of our City.
